


Application Instructions:

- Applicants must complete the general scholarship application through their Naviance account and/or one of the separate application forms available in the school counseling office or linked on the 2nd page of this document. This general application is basically a common application that will put applicants in the running for all scholarships except those that require a separate or supplemental application (listed on the 2nd page of this handout).
 - Login to NAVIANCE through your CLEVER account
 - Choose ABOUT ME (upper right)
 - Choose SURVEYS FROM YOUR SCHOOL
 - Click on the 2023 Senior Scholarship Application Form
 - Complete and submit
 - Please see your counselor before the deadline if you are unable to login or if you are unsure whether or not your submission went through
- Application window is open until 3PM on Friday, March 17th.
- You are able to save and return later to finish as needed.
- Applications are due **Friday**, **March 17th by 3PM**. At that time, the link will no longer be active. No late applications will be accepted. Please plan ahead!

Last year the MWHS Local Scholarship Program awarded over \$300,000!

- Majority of scholarships are worth \$1000 or more.
- Most scholarships are one time awards, but there are a few scholarships that are 2-year or 4-year renewable scholarships.
- The scholarships listed on page 2 require a separate application form/process.
- Most scholarships are available to any student planning to study as part of a technical/trade, 2-year, or 4-year program next year. Several scholarships are tagged specifically to students planning to study at a 2-year or technical/trade program.
- It is worth your time to apply!





An invitation to Scholarship Awards Night will indicate that a student is being awarded a scholarship, but in most cases students will not find out specifically which scholarship they will be receiving until that evening.

Once scholarship winners complete the first grading period at their post-secondary institution in the Fall of 2023, grades must be submitted to MWHS. Upon receipt of grades, scholarship checks will be sent. (*Some donors handle scholarship payout a little differently. Specifics will be included in spring communication.)

Ridgeview Health Care Scholarship

- Application and information found online at: <u>Application Link</u>
- Application deadline: Friday, March 17th 2023. Follow instructions for submission of online application
- Criteria: Pursuing one of the identified health career areas, 2.5 GPA or higher, school or community volunteer, planning to attend post-secondary school in Fall 2023.
- Single grant of \$2000

Mound Westonka Rotary and Rotary Interact Scholarships

- Applications available in the Counseling office (paper application) or at application links above.
- Application deadline: postmarked by April 3rd 2023 sent directly to the Rotary Club address provided on the application
- Criteria: Planning to attend a 2- or 4- year college in Fall 2023 (all scholarships), active member of Interact Club (Interact scholarship only).
- Application components: application form, copy of most recent grade report, essay, letter of recommendation from teacher, letter of recommendation from community member
- One grant at \$1000 for Rotary Scholarship and one grant at \$1000 for the Rotary Interact Scholarship.

Mound Masonic Lodge #320 Scholarship

- Application available in the Counseling Office (paper application) or at this Application Link.
- **Application deadline: Friday, March 17th by 3:00 PM:** Can submit through hard copy (to the counseling office), shared document (to Ms. Kampa), email pdf copy (to Ms. Kampa)
- Criteria: academic performance, contribution to community, career goals, leadership, financial need
- Application Components: application form, typed 1-page essay, letter of recommendation (optional)
- Single grant of \$1000

John Rasmussen Memorial Scholarship

- Submit the general Local Scholarship Application through Naviance AND submit the <u>John Rasmussen Memorial</u> <u>Scholarship Supplemental Questionnaire</u> (paper version available in the counseling office)
- Application deadline: Friday, March 17th by 3:00 PM Naviance application submitted online and supplemental questionnaire turned into the counseling office, shared or emailed to Ms. Kampa.
- Criteria: MALE or FEMALE student planning to attend a 4-year college in Fall 2023, 3.3 cumulative GPA or better, multi-year letter winner in either hockey or golf.
- Single grant of \$1000

James J. Jackson Memorial Scholarship

- Submit the general Local Scholarship Application through Naviance AND submit the <u>James J. Jackson Memorial</u> <u>Scholarship Supplemental Questionnaire</u> (paper version available in the counseling office).
- Application deadline: Friday, March 17th by 3:00 PM Naviance application submitted online and supplemental questionnaire turned into the counseling office, shared or emailed to Ms. Kampa.
- Criteria: 3-sport athlete in high school planning to attend a 2- or 4-year college in Fall 2023.
- Single grant of \$1250

BeLikeTommy Scholarship

- Submit the general Local Scholarship Application through Naviance AND submit the <u>BeLikeTommy Scholarship</u> <u>Supplemental Essay</u> (paper version available in the counseling office) addressing examples of being inclusive, kind, and bringing joy to those that need it.
- Application deadline: Friday, March 17th by 3:00 PM Naviance application submitted online and supplemental essay turned into the counseling office, shared or emailed to Ms. Kampa.
- Criteria: Student looking to pursue additional education or professional training in Fall 2023.
- Single grant of \$1000
