- Majority of scholarships are worth \$1000 or more.
- Most scholarships are one time awards, but there are a few scholarships that are 4-year renewable scholarships.
- Most all scholarships are available to any student planning to study at a 2- or 4-year college next year and several scholarships are tagged specifically to students planning to study at a 2-year or technical program.
- It is worth your time to apply!







- Single grant of \$1250
