

Voting has never been easier. Minnesota law allows any eligible voter to vote early by absentee ballot (in person or by mail) March 25 through May 9. On Election Day, May 10, polls will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

In-person absentee/early voting

Who can vote?

Anyone 18 years or older by May 10, 2016 and living in Westonka School District can vote absentee/early.

Where do I vote?

Absentee/early voting is held at the Westonka Educational Service Center, 5901 Sunnyfield Road E., Minnetrista.

When can I vote?

March 25-May 9 - Monday-Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (except March 28, when the office will be closed)

Thursday, May 5 - 7:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.

Saturday, May 7 - 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Monday, May 9 - 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

What do I need to vote?

Just you! If you are a registered voter, simply provide your name and address to vote absentee.

If you are not registered:

- You can register to vote and vote absentee at the same time
- You will need a completed application (available in the office) and proof of residence, such as a driver's license.

Absentee/early voting by mail

Who can request a ballot by mail?

Any Westonka resident, including college students and temporary out-of-town residents, may request an absentee ballot be mailed to them.

How do I request an absentee ballot?

Request a mailed ballot by filling out an Absentee Ballot Application. Ballots are available at the Educational Service Center or online at <http://mnvotesinfo.sos.state.mn.us/>. Applications may be turned in by someone other than the applicant, but ballots must be mailed.

Applications can be scanned and e-mailed to Carol Shukle in the School Board Office (shuklec@westonka.k12.mn.us), mailed (5901 Sunnyfield Road E. Minnetrista, MN 55364) or faxed (952.491.8012). Be sure to give your Westonka address as your actual address and your college/winter address as your mailing address. Ballots must be mailed to the applicant and may not be picked up by someone else.
