# Directions for setting up your voicemail

- 1. Click on the envelope icon button
- 2. Enter the default pin of 123123 and press ok and then the more button (soft keys)
- 3. Press the down arrow (silver arrow keys above the keypad) one time and select the dial into voicemail option using the ok button (middle silver button).
- The phone should enter in the default password (123123) If not enter this again STOP! Wait until prompted to continue
- 5. You will then be prompted to enter a new pin (this must be six digits and will need to be entered in twice) followed by the pound sign (#) You should hear a message that you were successful - The following steps can be completed at a later time but will be much easier to complete at the same time
- 6. Press 0 to enter the mailbox options
- 7. Press 2 to record your message and then hit pound when you are done
- 8. Press 2 to listen to your message and hit 1 to save it
- 9. Hang up

### Directions retrieving your voicemail from you own phone

- 1. Click on the envelope icon button
- 2. Enter your pin number and press ok (soft key or silver button)
- 3. Voicemail screen should be showing
- 4. Use the Soft Keys to play/delete messages and silver keys to move up and down through the messages.

# Directions retrieving your voicemail from another phone in district

- 1. Dial \*98
- 2. When asked enter your extension followed by the pound sign (#)
- 3. Enter your pin number followed by the pound sign (#)
- 4. Follow the voice prompts to listen to your voicemail

# Directions retrieving your voicemail from outside the district

- 1. From outside line, dial 952-491-8010
- 2. When greeting begins dial \*98
- 3. When asked enter your extension followed by the pound sign (#)
- 4. Enter your pin number followed by the pound sign (#)
- 5. Follow the voice prompts to listen to your voicemail

### <u>Menus</u>

#### Main Menu

- 1 key listen to new voicemail
- 2 key listen to old messages
- 0 key mailbox options
- \* key help
- # key exit

### Voicemail playback options for:

- calling from another district phone
- calling from out of the district
  - 5 key replay message
  - 7 key delete voicemail
  - 8 key forward voicemail to another extension
  - 9 key same this message
  - \* key help
  - # key exit
- Calling from your phone use soft keys for menu

### Personal Options for mailbox

- 1 key Use standard greeting (the person at extension 0000 is unavailable, please leave a message)
- 2 key Record New Greeting
- 3 key Standard Name
- 4 key Record Name
- 5 key Change pin (needs to be at least 6 digits long)
- \* key return to main menu

### Notes

• While listening to voicemail you are not in the voice mailbox to change greetings and settings.
