Graduation Requirements - Class of 2025

- Pass all required courses
 - o 4 credits English
 - 3.5 credits Social Studies
 - o 3.0 credits Math (including Statistics)
 - 3.0 credits Science (including Physical Science, Biology and Chemistry or Physics)
 - 0.5 credits PE
 - o .25 credits Health
 - o .25 credits Speech
 - 1.0 credit of Visual or Performing Arts
- 23.5 Total Credits

^{*}There is 4-year planning worksheet online that you can use to track graduation requirements and plan for the next years.

Required Courses for Grade 11

- 1.0 credit English
 - English 11 or Honors American Lit
- 1.0 credit Social Studies
 - World History, Advanced World History or AP World History
- 1.0 credit of Math
 - Determined by your current math course and performance in that course
- 1.0 credit of Science
 - o Graduation Requirement: Physical Science, Biology and some level of Chemistry or Physics
 - Classes that count for Physics credit: Physics, AP Physics, PLTW Principles of Engineering with Physics

Required Courses

Other courses needed to satisfy graduation requirements or college admission requirements/recommendations

- Statistics (graduation requirement)
 - Geometry with Stats
 - **FST**
 - Online General Stats
 - Online AP Stats
 - Applied Math
- Fine Arts (graduation requirement)
 - 1.0 credit (2 semesters) required in grades 9-12
 - List of courses that satisfy that requirement on next slide
- o Foreign Language (college admission)
 - Many 4-year colleges strongly recommend at least 2 years of foreign language
