What to keep in mind when registering for classes

- High school graduation requirements
- Plans for after high school (including college admissions requirements)
- Interests and abilities
- Classes that you may want to take in 10th-12th grades
- Always easier to drop a class for a prep period later (not as easy the other way around)
- Sign up for a challenging yet manageable course load

You should NOT make decisions based on:

- Classes that your friends are taking
- Which class is the easiest
- Who teaches the course

Your course selections play an important role in creating the master schedule for next year!

Please make thoughtful selections.

 Do research and get your questions answered prior to submitting requests.

 Future changes to course selections are not guaranteed.

Elective course selections are only requests at this time

 We do our best to honor your first choice selections, but sometimes that is not possible (course is cancelled due to low enrollment, conflict with another course, etc.)

 Therefore, each students will be asked to identify 3 alternate elective course options.
