CREDIT RECOVERY

If a student fails a required course, they will need to recover that credit in one of the following ways:

- 1. **Retake** the same course during a subsequent semester or year. This may be the only option to make up credit with some courses.
- Summer School summer school offers credit recovery for students who are 16 years or older in English, Social Studies, Math, Science, Health, P.E or Work Experience (elective), and 14-15 year olds in Geography and English if enrollment numbers support it. The Apex Learning Curriculum is used. The summer school schedule and details become available in May each year. Please see your school counselor to register for summer school in late May.
- Night School night school offers credit recovery for students who are 16 years or older in English or Work Experience (elective). Night school meets once a week after school for 2 hours (4-6 pm during 22-23 school year). Students can register for one night school course (worth .5 credits) during each semester. The Apex Learning Curriculum is used. Please see your school counselor for details.
- 4. Learning Lab Learning Lab is a credit recovery option offered during the school day via supervised online coursework. The Apex Learning Curriculum is used, learning is facilitated by the classroom teacher in a small class setting where work is done independently. Requests for registration are to be sent to the student's counselor and are prioritized based on student need. Learning Lab spots are limited!
