

HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT BEARING OPTIONS FOR 8TH GRADE

Starting with the class of 2021, MWHS credit can be awarded to students taking core courses (Math, Science, Social Studies and English) and World Language courses in 8th grade that are offered to 9-12 graders. Parents/Students would opt-in by the conclusion of their junior year if wanting to take the credit and letter grade from the applicable course(s) taken in 8th grade. A form will be available to families from the school website for submission. The letter grade will be part of a student's cumulative grade point average (GPA) and listed on their official MWHS transcript in the 9th grade section. The attendance policy would also be followed and if violated, a letter would be sent home at the conclusion of the course, stating the student would not be eligible for high school credit due to the attendance requirements.
