Pesticide Notification School Year 2019-2020

Dear Parent or Guardian:

Minnesota statute requires that school districts inform parents and guardians if the district applies certain pesticides on school property.

Specifically, the law requires schools applying such pesticides to maintain an estimated schedule of pesticide applications and to make the schedule available to parents and guardians for review or copying at each school office. State law also requires that you be informed that the long-term health effects on children from the application of such pesticides, or the class of chemicals to which they belong, may not be fully understood.

If you would like to be notified prior to pesticide applications made on days other than those specified in the estimated schedule (excluding emergency applications), please complete and return the form below.
